

**Selectboard, Town of Plymouth**  
**Monday, July 20, 2020**  
**Regular Meeting Minutes**

- Shawn called the Meeting to Order at 6:02 pm.
- Introductions were made.
- The only changes to the Agenda were that Kathy Billings could not be present due to illness, and Mike Coleman was added to the Agenda.
- Minutes from the Meeting of 6/15/20 were reviewed, approved, and signed.
- Mail was reviewed.
- Katharine and Roderick Pingree spoke about having a pickle ball court at the CC, and outlined some of the requirements. The fence will be contributed by LaValley, and the Pingrees will provide additional information on this at the next meeting. Sandie will check with the VLCT about liability insurance.
- Andy Crossman brought in the Welcome to Plymouth sign he redid for the Town. He advised that there were other Welcome signs that needed re-doing and he could do these, but there would be a charge. He also stated that the Cemetery may require additional funding for the next year, perhaps \$3,000, and that there were no grants available.
- Mike Coleman appeared next and discussed the Zoning Board presentation regarding ABLE Waste Management, which was dismissed by the Judge. Mike felt that it might be best not to do anything at this time. He also mentioned that the ATV Club will be putting up signs regarding trimming/upgrading; probably no zoning permit required; Mike will provide AI and the F&G with maps.
- Warrants were reviewed, approved, and signed.
- Rick Kaminski stated that roadside cutting and grading was being done.
- Susan Mordacai and Lisa Weiss spoke about a few items: community composting...was it a possibility; Air B & B...many are springing up and there should be some control by the Town, perhaps permits, an enforcer, leaving garbage behind; and the Dead End Road condition.....washed out on both side making it a one lane road; can the speed limit be changed, and use by ATVs.
- Under new business: the tax rate will be set on Tuesday. Sandie will get info on digitizing land records. Sandie will set the next SB meeting for an appearance regarding Bridge 114. The Town roads list will be sent to the SB.
- Under old business: the Sheriff's contract was discussed. Roof bids were discussed, the chosen bid was from Josselyn. The Traffic Ordinance was corrected. Shawn will truck wood chips to the CC.

The Meeting was adjourned at 8:00 pm.
