

**Selectboard of Plymouth
Monday, June 21, 2021
Regular Meeting Minutes**

Members: Jay Kullman, Chair; Rick Kaminski; Keith Cappellini

Others: Gannon Osborn (VT Parks and Rec) and his colleague; Sandie Small

- Jay called the Meeting to Order at 6:00 pm.
- Introductions were made.
- There were no changes to the Agenda.
- There was a correction to the Minutes of 5/17/21 so signing was tabled.
- There was no mail
- Warrants were reviewed, approved, and signed.
- The Road Commissioner's Report: mowing on the roads and tree cutting continues; the Hale Hollow bank improvement project will be put out to bid, as well as the new hydrant on Hale Hollow Road; the grader and the front-end loader will be rebuilt rather than purchasing new ones.
- Gannon spoke about the 386 acres to be given to Coolidge State Park by the VT Parks and Recreation. These were lands held in historic preservation and will now be transferred to the Park. (The SB will write a letter to VtPR regarding the concerns of continuing the current VAST trails.) Jay motioned to accept the transfer; Rick seconded; so voted.
- NEMRC did not appear.
- Under new business: the Audit was tabled until the next Meeting; the issue of fines for violations was also tabled; Pat from Okemo TV will propose some suggestions for Zoom meetings for the SB and the Zoning/Planning boards; the municipal tax rate was tabled; the Town Clerk was appointed the CDT, it was voted to deposit the delinquent tax fee into the Town's general fund and Jay motioned, Rick seconded; so voted. Discussion followed on unassigned funds for the budget...and bidding for projects.
- Under old business: the only current ad is for the HW Department; Rick will follow up with the Sheriff's contract; the new website is almost completed; Rick is meeting with GMP and Efficiency VT regarding the insulation at the Town Hall; the fire doors at the Town Hall have been done and are awaiting approval by the State Fire Dept; Rick stated that foam insulation may be added to the outside of the building, and that the masonry may be put on hold. The STR ordinance is put on hold. Jay will draft a letter regarding the Zoning Administrator.
- The next Meeting is scheduled for TUESDAY, July 6, 2021, at 6:00 pm.

The Meeting adjourned at 7:30 pm.
